

Supported by donations from local businesses, SPARK has been able to garner nearly half a million dollars in grant funding for Prince William County teachers and schools, as well as to School Division departments, staff, and offices, through our "Innovative Grants" program. This money allows schools and departments to implement programs that would not be possible otherwise. The Foundation continues to support the use of SchoolFusion, a one-of-a-kind Web site solution, in all 92 Division schools and continues to support students pursuing careers in teaching through the Dr. Edward L. Kelly Memorial Scholarship Fund.

Each year SPARK embarks upon new initiatives to help make education brighter for our students. We now support more than seven scholarship funds; play a vital role in the VA STAR computer education and refurbishment program; provide clothes and gifts to families in need via our Holiday Helpers initiative; and continue to grow our newest fundraising campaign, Eats for Education. 2010-11 HIGHLIGHTS

INNOVATIVE GRANTS

Funds invested in programs that directly and measurably impact student achievement. These programs may impact a single classroom, a team of teachers, an individual school, or the entire School Division. Whatever their size, scope, or purpose, they represent a profound belief that **every child can be successful.**

This year's Innovative Grants:

- "Destination Discovery," a multi-faceted science project that **boosts student interest and enthusiasm by increasing the number of hands-on activities** and projects made available to them.
- Funding which provides students with intellectual disabilities the opportunity to use technology to develop original, professional quality training tapes to **teach job readiness** skills and prepare students to successfully transition from high school to independent living.
- "Hootin' Hollerin' Poetry Slam," **a new approach to teaching poetry** that will strengthen students' listening skills and enable them to find language that will broaden their expression in both the written and spoken word.
- **Funded a butterfly garden** so elementary students can plant a garden with host plants that attract butterflies, which then allows them to observe an ecosystem and its life cycle.
- **Develop leadership capacity** in future generations by providing leadership training for students, staff, and community members using the principals established by Stephen Covey in his books "The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People," and "The Leader in Me," with a goal of bringing schools and community resources together.
- Expanding **FIRST LEGO League (FLL)** robotics programs in several Division elementary schools which help to promote the STEM program.
- **"Can You Hear Me Now?"** a program that uses a sound-field system that allows students in the classroom to hear the teacher's voice above other background noises. The program aims to improve vocabulary, listening, and reading comprehension.



- Provide students with the opportunity to **attend a live theater performance** that addresses some of the interpersonal experiences students encounter in their lives, and provide positive role models and depict appropriate ways for them to handle difficult situations.
- **"SURF, Summer Reading is Fun,"** to help students meet Standards of Learning (SOL) goals by providing reading support to English as a Second Language (ESOL) and economically disadvantaged students through a summer reading program.
- Assist students to develop critical thinking skills by using the Music Ace Maestro education program to **create their own musical compositions.**
- Develop a program that will create a "PSA" Club for students to create public service announcements which will be broadcast to their peers each morning at school. The goal is that the announcements will assist students in developing a more **positive attitude towards learning** so they will realize the value of furthering their education beyond high school.
- Funded "Kindle the Love of Reading": through the use of technology using E-Readers to "Promote Literacy for At-Risk Students," and **spark an interest in literature** in English for the English Second Language (ESOL) students.

SCHOLARSHIPS

- Awarded \$1,000 each to four high school seniors to further their education in a teaching career by the Dr. Edward L. Kelly Memorial Scholarship program.
- Distributed funds in the amount of \$900 from the Caulkins Construction General Education Development (GED) fund to the PWCS Office of Adult Education as scholarships to support students pursuing their GED.
- Awarded two \$1,500 scholarships to student athletes from the Derek Crowe Scholarship Fund.
- Awarded two \$1,000 scholarships from Washington Korean Women's Society.
- Awarded a \$1,000 scholarship from the Kristin M. Harkness Memorial Fund.
- Awarded three \$1,000 scholarships from the Austin Trenum Memorial Fund.
- Awarded the first \$250 scholarship from the "Yorkshire Elementary School" Scholarship fund.
- Collected funds for and managed activity for the Paul A. Wilson Memorial and "YES" (Yorkshire Elementary School) Scholarship funds.



- Use of Apple iPads for students who are challenged with the lack of fine motor skills by giving them an opportunity to learn through the use of touch/movement, sound, and visual stimulation.
- **Development of the first elementary level school band program.** Participation in the band will improve student academic performance (students must maintain a C average), create positive attitudes, and provide a source of pride for the Yorkshire community. Funds will be used to purchase instruments.

PROGRAM SUPPORT

- Continued fundraising with the “Holiday Helpers” giving program which **provides food, gifts, and warm clothing to families-in-need** identified by community partners and the School Division.
- Provided extensive **support and financial assistance to the VA STAR** (Virginia Student Training and Refurbishment) program located in several schools.
- Continued support for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) Education Coordinator position, which **provides a robust selection of robotics programs and other STEM career and technical education initiatives** to all the schools in PWC.
- Continued support by providing more than \$75,000 in funding for the “SchoolFusion” initiative, raised by leasing and managing commercial advertising space on all PWCS school Web sites. “SchoolFusion” **provides an online communication platform for teachers, students, and parents so they can share information.**

ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS

- Hosted the “Saluting Our Stars” celebration event to **recognize significant scholastic, artistic, and athletic achievements**, as well as honor those individuals and businesses that made a significant impact on education and learning in Prince William County.
- Sponsored the 18th Annual “Tee Off for Education” golf classic **fundraising event.**
- Hosted the 11th Annual Superintendent’s Business Breakfast to provide a “State of the Schools” update and **spotlight the School Division’s commitment to excellence.**
- Continue the “Eats for Education” fundraiser with local restaurant **partnerships to raise additional funds** for the Foundation programs and initiatives.


