The recipient will be a graduating Senior at Brentsville District High School; will have a cumulative GPA of 3.6; have been on a Brentsville Varsity athletic team; and is pursuing a degree in a 4 year institution of higher learning. One scholarship will be awarded each year in the amount of \$1000.

Eligibility Criteria:

Applicants Must:

- Be a graduating Senior at Brentsville District High School
- Be accepted to a four year program at an accredited institution of higher learning.
- Have a GPA of 3.6 or greater (high school transcript required)
- Have participated on a varsity athletic team at Brentsville District High School and earned a Varsity letter

Selection Committee:

A selection committee made up of BDHS staff and community leaders reviews all Scholarship applications on a competitive basis. At the committee's discretion a panel interview may be conducted. The decisions of the committee are final.
